WHAT'S INVOLVED IN THIS STUDY?

Participation in this study includes taking a survey and performing physical activity tests. The survey asks questions about you, your health, and activities that you perform with your prosthesis (or prostheses). The physical activity tests include tests like standing on one leg, side-shuffling, running around cones, and walking as fast as you can for 2 minutes. The study should take about 30 minutes.



You will receive \$50 for participating in the study.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

If the list below describes you, then this study may be right for you:

- You are 18 years of age or older
- You are able to read, write, and understand English
- You have an amputation between your ankle and hip in one or both of your legs
- You have no other amputations
- You have used a prosthesis (or prostheses) for 3 months or more
- You use your prosthesis (or prostheses) for high-level activities like jogging or running
- You can walk quickly for 2 minutes with your prosthesis
- You can get up from the ground (lying down to standing) without help
